

ARCHITECTURE OF GRACE

Connect Your School's Sheet

A 5-minute setup so self-reflections sync to a Google Sheet your school owns. Architecture of Grace stores nothing.

What you'll need: a Google account, the file AoG-Sheet-Sync-Code.gs, and about five minutes.

1	Make your Sheet. Create a new Google Sheet — this becomes your private system of record. (Or import AoG-Sheet-Template.xlsx for ready-made tabs.)
2	Open Apps Script. In the Sheet: Extensions ► Apps Script. Delete any sample code and paste in AoG-Sheet-Sync-Code.gs.
3	Set your passcode. Project Settings (gear) ► Script properties ► Add: name SHEET_PASSCODE, value a secret you choose (e.g. lincoln-2026-x7q4).
4	Deploy as a Web app. Deploy ► New deployment ► Web app. Execute as: Me. Who has access: Anyone. Click Deploy, authorize, and copy the Web app URL (it ends in /exec).
5	Connect in the dashboard. AoG dashboard ► Distribute ► “Connect your school's Sheet.” Paste the /exec URL and the same passcode, then Save and Test.

You're connected when... a row marked “(connection test)” appears in your Sheet. Delete it any time. New self-reflections now flow in, and the multi-year Trajectory builds itself.

The one privacy rule. Give each student a CODE, never their name. Keep the code-to-name list only on the Sheet's private Roster tab — it is never synced and never leaves your school. Everything Architecture of Grace receives is pseudonymous.

Privacy-first • Sheets-first • School-owned • Portable-later. *Your data stays in your Google Workspace. You can export or leave at any time.*
